Data Collection

Data collection for SELF's 2002 Excess Liability and Workers' Compensation actuarial studies has begun. Our actuary has decreased the number of required fields this year to make it easier for our members to gather and submit data. The deadline for data submission is July 31, 2001. The data specifications and a sample report have been mailed to each member and are also available online.

Memorandum of Coverage Approved

The SELF Board of Directors approved the revisions to the Memorandum of Coverage at its last Board Meeting on June 29. The main changes include revisions to the Employment Practices Liability coverage and claims reporting and notice requirements. You should receive your copy of the revised Memorandum of Coverage in early fall.
