

University Activity Informed Consent

The attached language has been reviewed and approved by University Legal Counsel and University Risk Management for use by the University to inform potential participants of risks involved in participation in specific activities of class assignments, labs, and projects. This form should not be used for internships or student teaching.

- The language and format of the document (Identified Risks of Participation) is not to be altered without consultation with the University Risk Manager.
- Copy the form on to a new document (it is write protected).
- The form should be placed on Cal Poly department, college or division letterhead. The Identified Risks of Participation header goes under the letterhead.
- The name and date of the specific activity should be inserted under the header (Identified Risks of Participation).
- Identified risk of participation should be concisely stated and include: injury and illness up to and including death and property damage and may include specific causes or additional specific injuries or results.
- The form should be signed by the participant (preferably 24 hours after it is presented) and maintained by the department responsible for the activity.
- The University does not maintain accident medical coverage for students or visitors on campus.
- The University entity (College or Division) responsible for the activity is responsible for the payment of the deductible for the University's liability insurance for each occurrence or claim related to the activity.
- Information for the participants including: preparation, materials, equipment, operations, safety, and regulatory requirements as required by the University's Injury and Illness Prevention Program should be provided separately, in written form with documented acknowledgement of receipt and compliance.
- Accidents or incidents involving injury, death or damage should be reported to University Risk Management as soon as possible.
- University Police should be called immediately to respond to any injury, death or damage to property (Business 756-2281) **EMERGENCY 911**
