The votes were tallied at the SELF office in Sacramento. SELF hired Sequoia Pacific Election Systems, an election-processing company, to run this year's election.

The board of directors will certify the election results following staff's verification of employment status (per section 5.2 of SELF's Policy and Procedures Manual) and welcome the new directors at the board meeting on June 27. The new board members will take office on July 1. SELF staff will provide new board and alternate member orientation during the summer months.

Every two years, elections are held for half the board members. Each director serves a four-year term. Schools Excess Liability Fund (SELF) is a statewide joint powers authority providing excess workers' compensation and liability coverage to nearly 1,100 California public educational agencies.
